Description:	IgnoreHtmlMarkups parameter regulates whether the text that is a part of HTML markup should be checked for spelling errors or ignored.
Parameter type:	Boolean
Default value:	0
Possible values:	• 0 – HTML tags and content surrounded by start and end tags are checked for spelling errors; • 1 – HTML tags are ignored and only the content surrounded by start and end tags is checked for spelling errors. Any text surrounded by angle brackets (<...>) or the text following an ampersand (&) until a semicolon (;) will be ignored. In the code sample below, with the default value set to 1, the text that will be checked for any spelling errors is “<i>Check your grammar and spelling mistakes as you types.</i>”.
